RE: Applications by Towne Wine & Liquor to Renew the Establishment's Retailer's Class "A" Liquor Store License at 1326 Wisconsin Avenue NW and to Transfer the Establishment's Retailer's Class "A" Liquor Store License to a New Location at 1438 Wisconsin Avenue NW (ABRA-093813)

Dear Chairperson Anderson,

On May 3, 2021 ANC 2E held its regularly scheduled public meeting, which was properly noticed and attended by seven commissioners, constituting a quorum. At this meeting the Commission adopted the following resolution by a vote of (7-0-0) with regard to the above-referenced matter:

ANC 2E has no objection to Towne Wine & Liquor's renewal application or to the establishment's application to transfer the establishment's license from 1326 Wisconsin Avenue NW to 1438 Wisconsin Avenue NW. The ANC is concerned, however, about the confusion regarding the licensed hours for the site.

Therefore, ANC 2E protests Towne Wine & Liquor's application to transfer the establishment's Retailer's Class "A" Liquor Store license to a new location at 1438 Wisconsin Avenue NW based on the adverse impact on the peace, order, and quiet of the neighborhood.
